The inmates of the new college hostel Banalata' successfully completed one year. The college canteen also has great attraction for the students.


In our effort to reach the unreached we run distance course through NSO'U with remarkable success.

INSTITUTIONAL ACADEMIC DEVELOPMENT

During 2016-17 Post Graduate Studies in Bengali & Commerce have started. In 2016 we forwarded our application to the Higher Education Council and on 2017 after inspection of the specialized team consisting of the University experts and members from the University of Calcutta we have received the required sanction and accordingly the first batch of the students are enrolled in this academic session. The Duke Library of the College, which has received the status of a heritage site, has been completely renovated in collaboration with the Howrah Municipal Corporation.
