The Department also conducted an **Environmental Audit Project** by data collection in Baidyabati Jheel, Hoogly during August-December 2019 with 19 participating students.

Department of Geography has organized a field work and excursion from November 6-13, 2019 for the Third Year students at Ranchi and Netarhat in Jharkhand. The broad objective of the field work was to correlate the physical and cultural elements of the chosen study area, i.e., Balalong village under Nagri tehsil in the peri-urban areas of Ranchi city. They also prepared a Land Use map of the study area. Along with it a household survey was

conducted to explore the socio-economic and demographic aspects with a special focus on the facets of multidimensional poverty of the local residents, who are mostly tribal. Moreover, a few thematic surveys like Market Survey and School Survey were also carried out. As a part of excursion, the fieldwork team went to selected places like Patratu valley, Hundru and Johna waterfalls and tropical deciduous forests of Netarhat.

Department of History has organized a visit to the Indian Museum, Kolkata on 13.11.2019 with their students as a field tour.

Department of Economics has organized to take the Honours students to a UGC sponsored curriculum workshop on 'Study of Economics & Plan for Higher Studies and Job Market' organized by Bankim Sardar College on 03.02.2020.
