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Music Competition

General instruction

1. Time for each performance is 3 minutes (Maximum)
2. Participants must submit lyrics, name of lyricist, name of composer before his/her/their performance.
3. College will provide Tabla, Hermonium and Tanpura. (No other instruments/ tract has been entertained. Band group have to arrange their own instruments)
4. Efficient Tabalia has been provided by college. Participants can arrange his/her own Tabalia at her own cost.
5. Candidates can participate maximum 3 events.

Band Music:

1. Time for each performance is 5-7 minutes (Maximum)
2. Music system will be provided by the college.
3. Participants in each group will be 2-5 (maximum).
4. No track music has been allowed during competition

Dance competition

1. Time limit Stage in Stage Out 5 minutes for each performance. Negative marking for exceeding the time limit.
2. Choice of song is open to the participants.
3. Costumes and other props for Dance have to be arranged by participants.

4. Participants must bring music(track) of their performances in mobile phone or in pen drive.
5. Green room would be given for changing purpose.
6. Dance performance should not convey any indecent gestures.
7. The decision of the judges will be last and final.

Recitation Competition

- ◆ **Participants can** participate in any category.
- ◆ **Time** limit of each recitation is maximum 4 minutes.
- ◆ Participants **must have** to inform their own name-college name- subject studying-and class.
- ◆ Name of the selected poet and poem must be informed by 7th December'23.
- ◆ **Photocopy** of the selected poem must be submitted to the judges in the scheduled date and time.
- ◆ Decision of the judges shall be deemed final.

"Onu Natak (Short Play)" Competition.*

1. The duration of the play is not more than 10 minutes.
2. The number of actors and actresses in the play is not more than 5.
3. Any play written - manuscript - printed - published or unpublished will be accepted.
4. Any theme based drama that attacks or disrespects any political party or any religious community will not be accepted in any way.
5. Composed soft copy of the play must be submitted to the authority 7 days prior to the performance date to the following mail ID bkgccultural@gmail.com
6. Plays in three languages Bengali, Hindi and English will be accepted.
7. Play groups should report latest by 10.30am on 15.12.2023
8. 2+1 = 3 minutes will be available for setting up and removing the set of the stage.

9. Necessary theatrical material should be brought by the competing troupe.
10. Authority will provide only one platform, greenrooms, two 500wt. + 500wt. Halogen, a microphone connection, a reading table, two chairs, one low bench.
11. The judges' decision will be considered as final.

Model competition

1. Topics:
 - A) Bio Science: 1- Recombinant DNA Technology and Transgenics; 2- Biodiversity conservation
 - B) Pure Science: 1- Electricity from bio-gas; 2- 3D structure of ionic and covalent compounds
 - C) Earth Science: 1- Fluvial Landforms; 2- Climate Change
2. Minimum 1, Maximum 3 participants per model
3. Each model needs to be demonstrated in front of the judges. Maximum permissible duration per demonstration is 5 minutes.

POSTER COMPETITION

Themes of the Poster Competition are:

1. **“Say No to Drug”**
2. **Energy Conservation**
3. **“The Right to Work and Education”**

General Guidelines for Presentation:

1. Candidates have to submit their poster in 3×3 inches art/Chart paper
2. Candidates have to explain their themes in front of judges
3. Duration of presentation will be 5 minutes

Quiz rules and regulations

The basic rule of the competition:

1. Only team entries are allowed, and team shall consist of four persons. There is not limit of teams from single institution.
2. The decision of the quiz-master will be final and will not be subjected to any change.
3. The participants shall not be allowed to use mobile or other electronic instruments during the quiz time.
4. The questions shall be in the form of objective questions, multiple choice, true/false statement, specific answer question etc.
5. Audience/Supporters shall not give any hints or clues to the competitors.
6. Replacement of any participant of a team is not allowed after registration.

There will be two round in the quiz competition,

1. Preliminary round or elimination round.
2. Final round or stage round.

Preliminary round:

Each team will be given a set of question paper containing objective type questions. The following rules will be application for the preliminary round.

- Time limit: 5 minutes.
- Each question will carry 1 mark.
- Only top 6 teams will be selected for final or stage rounds.
- In case of tie between 2 or more teams, further 5 questions will be asked for final selection.

This step will be continued till the selection of 6 teams.

- The selected teams shall have to appear for the final round.

Final quiz/stage round:

The final round will be comprised of following rounds,

1. Round 1: India's Independence movement/history/politics
2. Round 2: Indian Geography.
3. Round 3: Indian and International Music, Film
4. Round 4: Science and Technology.
5. Round 5: Audio/visual round.
6. Round 6: Indian Economy
7. Round 7: Indian literature
8. Round 8: Current affairs
9. Round 9: Who Am I?
10. Round 10: Rapid fire round.

The following rules will be application for the final round,

- I. 10 marks will be awarded for correct answer.
- II. Response time for each question is 30 seconds.
- III. There is no pass option.
- IV. Team discussion is allowed.
- V. In the rapid fire round, each team will be asked 3 question one after another. 10 marks will be awarded for the correct answer and 5 marks will be deducted for each wrong answer.

MOBILE PHOTOGRAPHY COMPETITION

1. Duration: 3 Hours
2. Place of Photography: College Campus
3. Theme: Still Life (To be announced)
4. Photograph: Black & White or Coloured
5. No Auto Editing is allowed
6. Each Participants has to submit 3 Photographs
7. Participants will have to submit the photographs through given mail id mentioning there Name, Roll Number, Name of College and Contact Number in body of the mail

Participants must keep the clicked and submitted photographs in their device till the judgement for further clarification

FACE-PAINTING COMPETITION-2023

- i) The Participants should bring one model with his/ her for face painting.
- ii) The theme of face-painting will be of their own choice.
- iii) The participants should bring colours and other necessary materials for face painting as college will not provide it.
- iv) The duration of the face-painting is 2hrs
- v) The participants will have to present the theme of face-painting (in 2-3 minutes) before the judges.

Art and Crafts

Theme: **My Art and Crafts My Creation**

Categories:

Ceramics: artwork clay, pottery, or similar materials, often covered in decorative stains, glazes, etc.

Drawings: artwork using drawing instruments such as graphite pencil, charcoal, colored pencil, silverpoint, or other dry medium on a piece of paper.

Metals and Jewelry: artwork predominantly created with metals to form sculptures, figurines, kinetic works, metal jewelry, etc.

Paintings: artistic work which uses the application of paint, pigment, color or other medium (i.e., acrylic, oil, ink, gouache, fresco) to a surface using brushes, knives, sponges, airbrush, etc.

1. Participants may choose any one of the above category
2. Participants should bring related raw materials
3. College will provide appropriate place for the participants
4. Duration 2 hrs

Rangoli

The candidates will have to bring the colours for Rangoli, brush and other necessary equipments.
